MACRO FLUCTUATIONS WITH MICRO FRICTIONS (MFMF)

The workshop will run for 2 days and will take place on **June 18-19, 2020** in Barcelona. (**Notice that the SED Meetings will also be in Barcelona on June 21-23*).

Brief description of the workshop

Our workshop focuses on the macroeconomic implications of frictions at the micro-level, such as adjustment costs, informational rigidities, search and matching frictions, irreversibility, among many others. Topics of particular interest include price/wage setting, capital and labor dynamics, international trade, durables, inventories, and portfolio management. Papers with strong theoretical and quantitative components, disciplined with microdata, are encouraged.

The **deadline for submissions** is **February 28, 2020**. To submit a paper, please use this link <https://app-summerforum.barcelonagse.eu>. Submissions should include a full paper. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified approximately by mid-March. A preliminary program will be announced by mid-April.

Please note that the Barcelona Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops. When you submit your paper, you will be able to see the topics and dates of other workshops that will take place within the Summer Forum. **The same paper cannot be submitted to more than one workshop, but you are welcome to submit a different paper to another workshop.**
